What is Dual Credit?

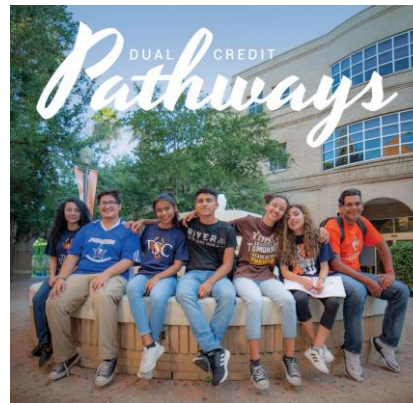
- Dual Credit is when students are enrolled in college courses during high school.
- Programs :
 - **Early College High School:** Students are expected to follow an Associate in General Studies Program of Study Pathway.
 - **Dual Enrollment :** Allows more flexibility in choosing how students wish to pursue the program of study.

Que Son Cursos de Doble Crédito?

- Doble Crédito son cursos que valen a nivel universitario y en preparatoria.
- Programas :
 - **Early College High School:** Se espera que los estudiantes sigan un Programa de Estudios de Asociado en Estudios Generales.
 - **Dual Enrollment :** Permite flexibilidad en la elección de cómo los estudiantes desean seguir el programa de estudio.

Dual Enrollment Student Pathways

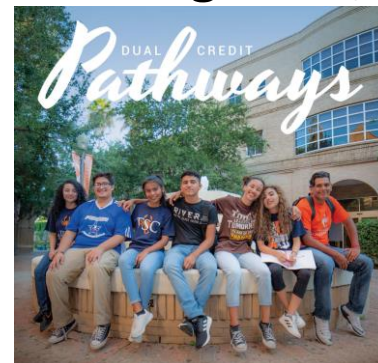
- A Pathway is a sequence of courses designed to take a student from high school to a college degree at TSC.
- Pathways give students, parents and counselors the opportunity to plan which courses to take in high school, and later on, which courses to take at TSC.
- Pathways are available for Core Curriculum Completion and Associate Degree programs in Business, Criminal Justice, Social Work & Teaching.

Benefits of taking Dual Credit Courses !

- Students are able to obtain college credit, which could be applied towards a TSC Certificate or Associate Degree.
- Students can transfer General Education Core Curriculum courses to public institutions of higher education in Texas.
 - Students may check the Texas Common Course Numbering System to verify if a course transfers to a certain institution at <https://www.tccns.org/>.
- Reduces the time to complete a college degree.
- Provides the opportunity to experience college courses.
- Improves understanding of what is required to succeed in college.
- There is no cost to the students and parents.



Cuáles son los beneficios de tomar Cursos de Doble Crédito?

- El programa de Crédito Dual provee una oportunidad a los estudiantes de preparatoria, que califican para tomar cursos universitarios, recibir crédito dual para la preparatoria y la universidad en TSC.
- El programa de Crédito Dual ofrece cursos técnicos y académicos. Crédito dual para los cursos académicos se refieren a clases que se transfieren a las universidades públicas en Texas.
 - Si algún estudiante quiere verificar si la clase de doble crédito puede ser aplicada a otro universidad que no sea TSC , puede verificar en la siguiente página de web.

- Estudiantes podrán reducir tiempo para terminar su plan de estudio.
- Tendrán la experiencia de haber tomado cursos universitarios.
- Tendrán conocimiento de las expectativas al tomar cursos universitarios.
- No hay costo al estudiante o padres.



Student Responsibilities

- Students must follow up with the Counselor for upcoming deadlines such as New Student forms, updated TSI scores, Add/Drop Forms and Withdrawal Forms.
- Students must submit all required documents by Deadline.
 - Failure to submit all documents by deadline might impact students eligibility to participate.
- Maintain an overall grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 or higher.
- Students need to communicate openly and honestly with instructors and counselors regarding issues that affect their academic performance or educational goals.
- Students must assume academic responsibility for successful completion of courses.



Responsabilidades del Estudiante

- Los estudiantes deben hacer un seguimiento con el consejero para las próximas fechas límites, de los formularios de nuevos estudiantes, los puntos actualizados de TSI, los formularios para agregar/dar de baja clases y los formularios para retirar clases.
- Los estudiantes deben presentar todo los documentos requeridos antes de la fecha límite.
 - No enviar todos los documentos antes de la fecha límite podría afectar la elegibilidad de los estudiantes para participar.
- Mantener un promedio general de calificaciones (GPA) de 2.0 o superior.
- Los estudiantes deben comunicarse de manera abierta y honesta con los instructores y consejeros con respecto a los problemas que afectan su desempeño académico o sus metas educativas.
- Los estudiantes deben asumir la responsabilidad académica para completar con éxito los cursos.



Student Academic Standing

Good Standing:

- Maintain a Grade Point Average of 2.0 or higher
- Complete 67% of the semester credit hours (SCH) attempted
 - [15 SCH = (10)]
 - [12 SCH = (8.7)]
 - [9 SCH = (6)]

Academic Probation:

- Any student who drops below an overall GPA of 2.0 .
- Any student with an Overall completion rate below 67% .
 - Withdrawing from a course
 - Incomplete
 - Letter grade of an "F"



Estado Académico del Estudiante

- **Buen Nivel Académico:**

Un estudiante en buen nivel académico mantiene un promedio general de 2.0. equivalente a una “C”.

- **Período de Prueba Académica :**

- Cualquier estudiante cuyo promedio de calificaciones baje de un 2.0 al final del semestre
- Cualquier estudiante que no complete el 67% de los cursos; situaciones que pueden afectar esto son:
 - Darse de baja de un curso
 - Una calificación incompleta
 - Calificación de letra “F”



Drop –vs- Withdrawal

- Drop
 - A course dropped before the census date during add/drop period.
 - Will not appear on a student transcript.
 - No letter grade received.
- Withdrawal
 - A course dropped after the census date.
 - Will appear on a student official transcript .
 - Letter grade of a “W”.
 - Will impact student completion rate.
- Student is required to submit a signed Withdrawal form on or before the established deadline with the following signatures for processing.
 - ✓ Student
 - ✓ Parent
 - ✓ School Counselor
- School Counselor is required to submit forms before deadlines.



Bajar- vs- Retirar

Dar de Baja un curso:

- Un curso que se dé de baja antes de la fecha de censo durante el período de agregar/dar de baja
- No aparecerá en el expediente académico del estudiante
- El estudiante no recibirá ninguna calificación con letras.

Retirar un curso:

- Después de la fecha del censo
 - Aparecerá en el expediente académico del estudiante como una “W”
 - Afectará la tasa de finalización de los estudiantes.

- Se requiere que el estudiante envíe un formulario de Retiro firmado el día de o antes de la fecha límite establecida con las siguientes firmas para su procesamiento: Estudiante, Padre, Consejero de la escuela
 - **Se requiere que el consejero escolar presente los formularios antes de las fechas límite.**

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) is a federal law that protects the privacy of student education records.

FERPA gives parents certain rights with respect to their children's education records.

- ❖ Third Party Authorization Form is required for any parent that would like to have access to their child's Academic Records.
- ❖ Parents do not have access to speak to TSC Adjunct Instructors regarding their child's academic progress in a course.

- La Ley de Derechos Educativos y de Privacidad de la Familia (FERPA) protegen la confidencialidad de los registros de educación de su hijo/a.
- FERPA es una ley federal de privacidad que les proporciona a los padres con ciertos derechos y protecciones con respecto a los archivos educativos del niño(a)
- ❖ Forma de autorización es requerida para que los padres tengan acceso a los registros académicos de sus hijos.
- ❖ Padres no tienen acceso a hablar con maestros de TSC sobre el progreso académico de sus hijos en una clase.

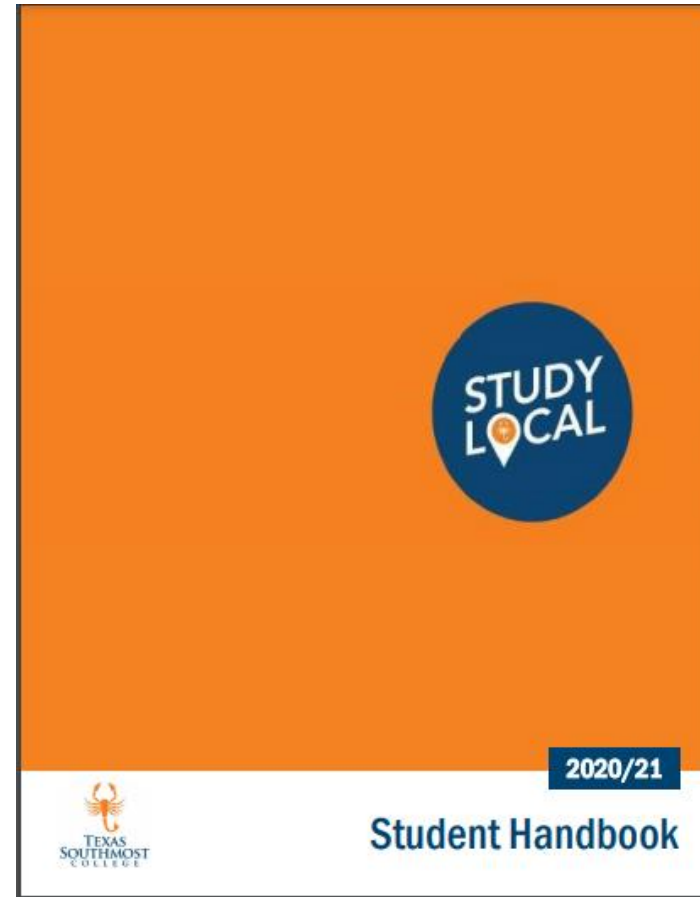

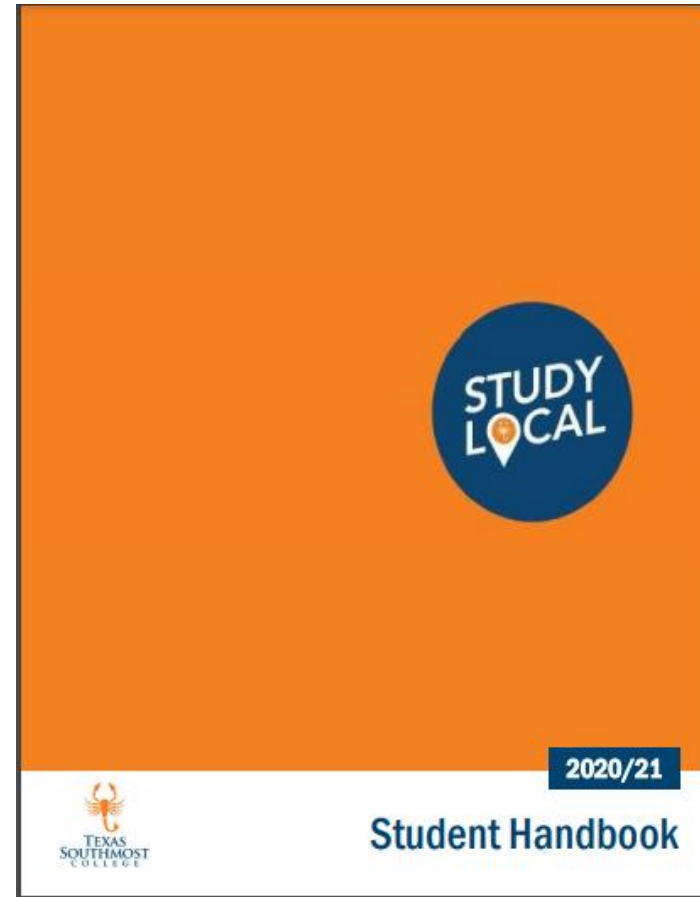
